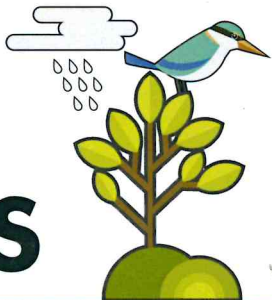


EVERY DROP COUNTS

Rainwater which would otherwise be lost, will be captured and used to feed street trees and plants using a new system of TREENET Inlets.

Look out for these new inlets in your street.

How do the inlets benefit your street?

- Each inlet captures more than 10,000 litres of water in an average year.
- This additional water helps the street plants and trees to grow and thrive.
- Healthy plants and trees make your street greener and more attractive.
- Trees also provide shade to help keep your street cooler in hot weather.

What if it has been very dry?

Feel free to top up the inlets by pouring in some water. This will help to keep your street trees green and healthy. Council will also water regularly in dry weather.
